Cottage/cleaning/items that previous guests may use.	Customers, host & cleaner	 Sign reminding guest to wash hands each time they enter cottage from outside. All rooms -All high touch surfaces & items cleaned/sanitized on each changeover to include surfaces, handles, door handles, light switches, inline lamp switches, radiators, banister rail. Tv/ remote. Bathrooms as above-remember taps. Kitchen as above remember- kettle, toaster, microwave, tea/ sugar cannister/sauce bottles. Tea pot/cafetiere handles. Lounge/bedrooms as above remember remote controls/ fire controls. Soap available at all the sinks including kitchen. Antibacterial surface cleanser left in the bathroom and kitchen for guests to use whilst they are staying. Note advising guests to leave any boardgames/ toys used out on kitchen worktop for sanitising. Plastic guest folder, sanitise each changeover. Provide minimal brochures of key local sites and one local map. Recycle these and provide fresh ones each stay. Inform guest of information websites eg.
